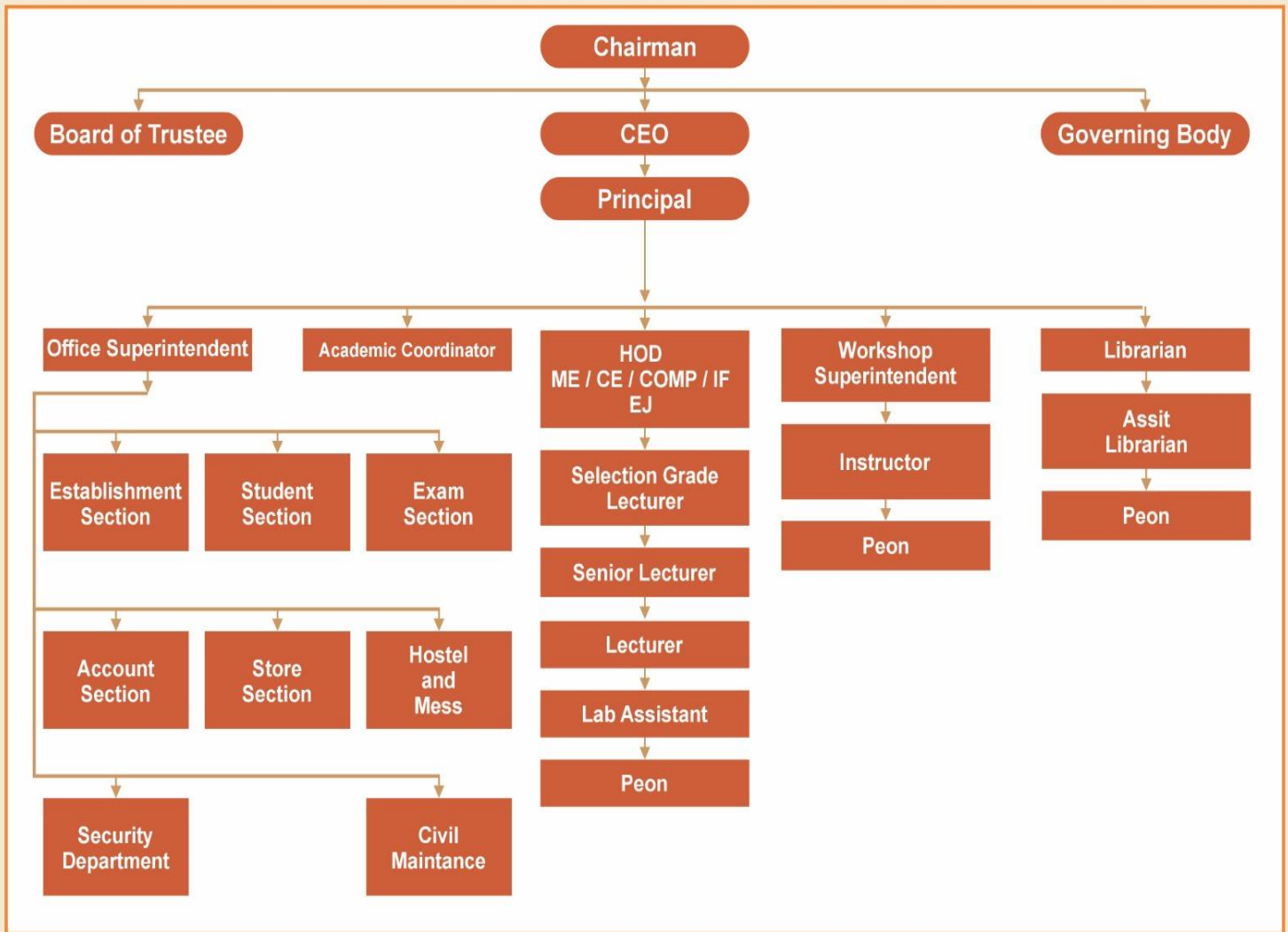
Organization Structure

- After receiving the application, the RTI Committee will make inquiry and provide the relevant information.

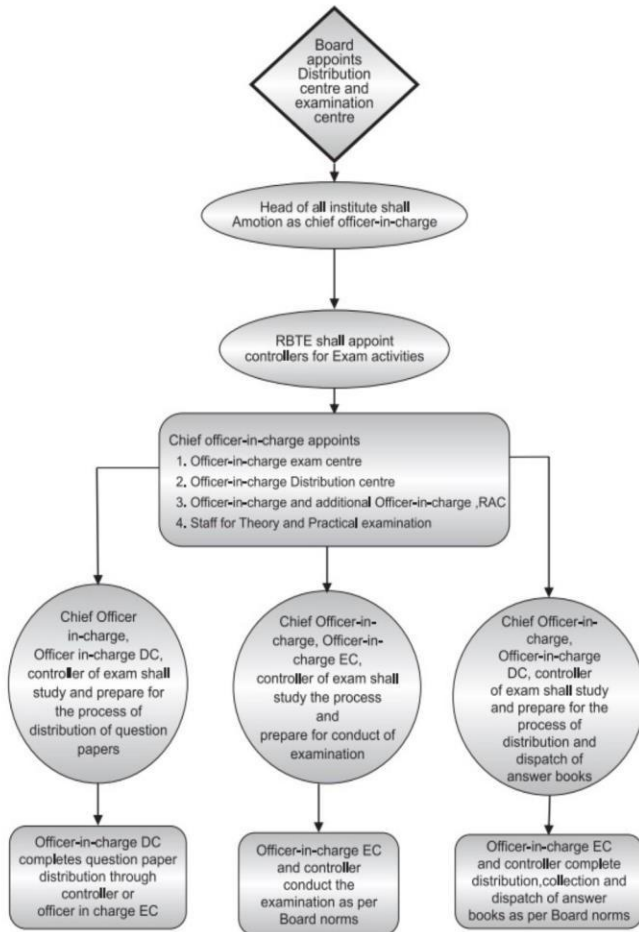
